However, paint protection film (sometimes called clear bra) helps protect your car's paint job.

How does it do it?

Paint protection film is literally a polyurethane film that adds an extra layer of protection to your vehicle.

It is formulated from a combination of advanced elastomeric polymers that prevent the film from discoloring, yellowing or hazing.
